

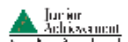

1. **Wider understanding**
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We need a wider understanding of “entrepreneurship education”

within the education system, the attitudes and skills of young people to self-employment, by developing personal qualities - such as creativity, responsibility, risk-taking, problem-solving, team-working - and relevant business competencies on how to create and run an

Two Dimensional

- “Hard” Knowledge
- “Soft” Skills

YES

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Ensure strong political commitment and support for entrepreneurship

- In order to get real “buy-in”, co-ordination and coherence in EE design and provision
- Be at the highest level (national and regional level)
- Be clearly and publicly articulated through a Statement, Policy or Plan

YES

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Ensure sustained funding for entrepreneurship education activities

- EE is resource “hungry”
- Needs to be kept up-to-date and relevant with latest developments e.g. in the economy and in social media space
- Requirement to “ring-fence” funding

YES

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Entrepreneurship education should span and be integrated across the full education cycle

- From primary through second-level and on into third-level
- Activities and projects should evolve in nature and intensity as one progresses through the education cycle

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Support to teachers

- Provide specific training on entrepreneurship
- Innovative actions required for training teachers
- Include when initially being trained/educated as a teacher and also as Continuous Professional Development (CPD) throughout the teaching career

- To assist schools and teachers
- Develop links between educational institutions and enterprises
- An important issue is to raise the awareness among entrepreneurs themselves about their key role in the education process
