Combine offline with online activities to ensure the future of mobility.



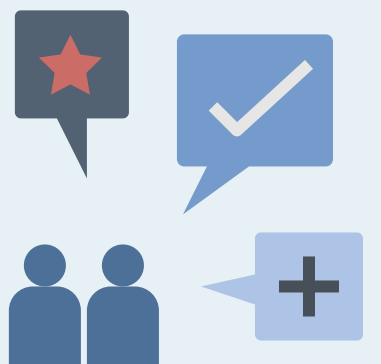
## 2. Evaluate the online feasibility.

Adopt a risk management approach to ensure resilience and flexibility.



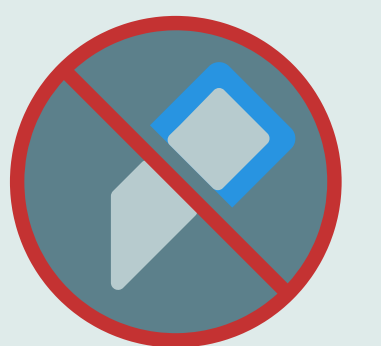
## 5. Plan online activities differently.
