EURODYSSEY ALLOWS FOR FLEXIBLE FINANCING!

CO-FUND THE HOSTING INFRASTRUCTURE

Regions mutually cover incoming trainees' living costs - salary, housing, food and transport - with the support of local companies

LANGUAGE TRAINING

The host region will give the opportunity to trainees to follow language courses

INSURANCE POLICY

The AER takes care of covering liability, hospitalisation and repatriation insurance for all the Eurodyssey participants

EU FUNDING FOR AFFORDABLE TRAINEESHIPS

AER supports regions in applying for the European Social Fund (ESF) to co-finance the Eurodyssey hosting costs
