WHAT

WHEN & WHERE

- The activities in the morning of 29 November and during the whole day of 30 November will take place in the government complex of <u>Landhaus St.</u>
 <u>Pölten (check on Google Maps)</u>
- The activities in the <u>afternoon of 29 November</u> will take place in the <u>House of Digitalisation in Tulln</u> (<u>check on Google Maps</u>). The venue is also reachable by train (<u>check itinerary here</u>).

How to get to Sankt Pölten

From Vienna International Airport to Sankt Pölten (train station)

- The fastest trains are called "railjet xpress" or "railjet."

How to get to the venue in Sankt Pölten

The event venue in Sankt Pölten in House A,
 Landhaus Boulevard 1, 3109. St. Pölten is at a walking distance from the train station (15 minutes)

How to get to the venue in Tulln

- For those interested in both the study trip and activities in Tulln, it is advisable to join the departures at 12.50 in front of the 'sound tower'/ Klangturm close to the main venue on 29 November.
- The venue is also reachable by train. It is at walking distance from the train station. <u>Check the</u> <u>itinerary here.</u>
